Criteria for Performing Arts Scholarship:

1. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.
2. The applicant must have participated in at least 3 Windham Center Stage Theater productions.
3. The applicant must be planning to attend an accredited post-secondary degree or certificate program and the performing arts or music will be their major or minor course of study.
4. The applicant must complete a minimum of 4 courses with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher their first semester of study in order to receive the scholarship.

Criteria for Community Theater involvement Scholarship:

1. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior.
2. The applicant must have participated in at least 3 Windham Center Stage Theater productions.
3. The applicant must have volunteered in at least 3 WCST events or productions for responsibilities beyond acting demonstrating commitment and leadership in community theater (Examples include but are not limited to: Assisting with choreography, directing, music, costumes, makeup, sound, lights, teen member of board of directors.)
4. The applicant must be planning to attend an accredited post-secondary degree or certificate program
5. The applicant must complete a minimum of 4 courses with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher their first semester of study in order to receive the scholarship.
